MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF THE NAVY:

Subject: Washington Document Center.

Reference: a. Director of Central Intelligence Confidential Memorandum on subject, dated 2 November 1946.

1. In reference a it was stated that if a favorable reply was received from the War Department on the request for the transfer of certain Army personnel to CIG incidental to the possible transfer of the Washington Document Center to CIG, notification would be made to the Navy Department.

2. The formal acceptance of the War Department of the CIG request has now been received. Therefore, if the Navy Department is able to accept the request made for the necessary vacancies to permit transfer of the required naval personnel, action may be commenced on the transfers with the assurance of formal CIG acceptance of the Washington Document Center.
